Notes:

I now play this song (live) a tone higher with the capo on the 3rd fret, so this is the tab for the album version (Legends of the Sun).

There's a lot going on in the album version but this is guitar 1's part. There is another guitar for the solos. It's a finger picking song and I mainly just play it by feel so I can't give you the pattern for it. It would probably take me a while to figure out and break it down for you. So just play it by ear:)

As a rough guide, keep your thumb plucking the root note (bass note) for each chord and let your other fingers do the rest. You should feel a rocking, "down-up down-up" motion in your right hand while playing this. I think Red Hot Chili Peppers song - "Road Trippin" inspired my guitar part to this song. The picking style is similar.

Ps: Oh, and try a hammer-on right at the end of the Am, and F chords with your index finger on your left hand before you change chords. That should give you the finishing touch!
